

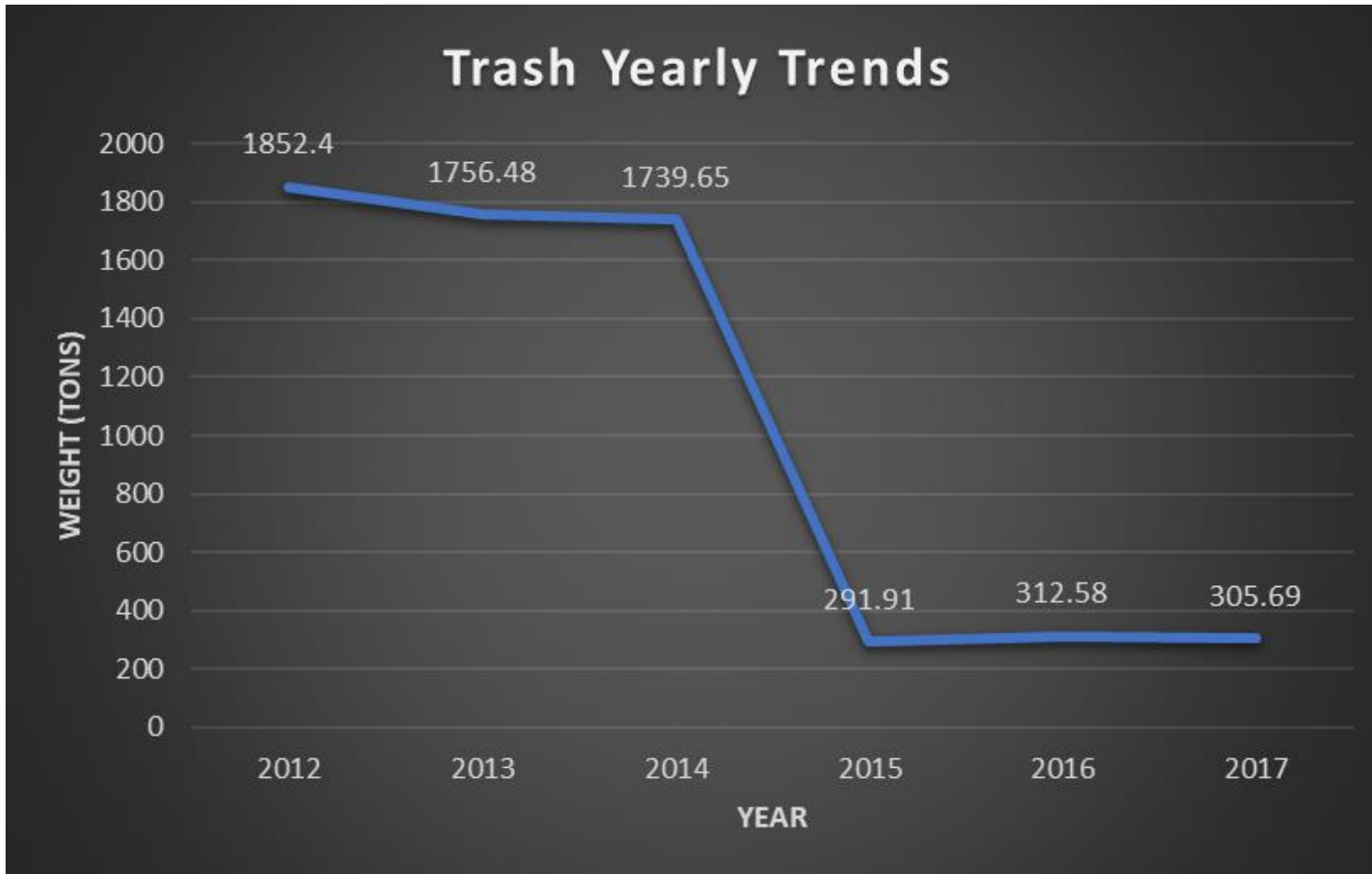

Fairfield University Trash and Recycling Trends

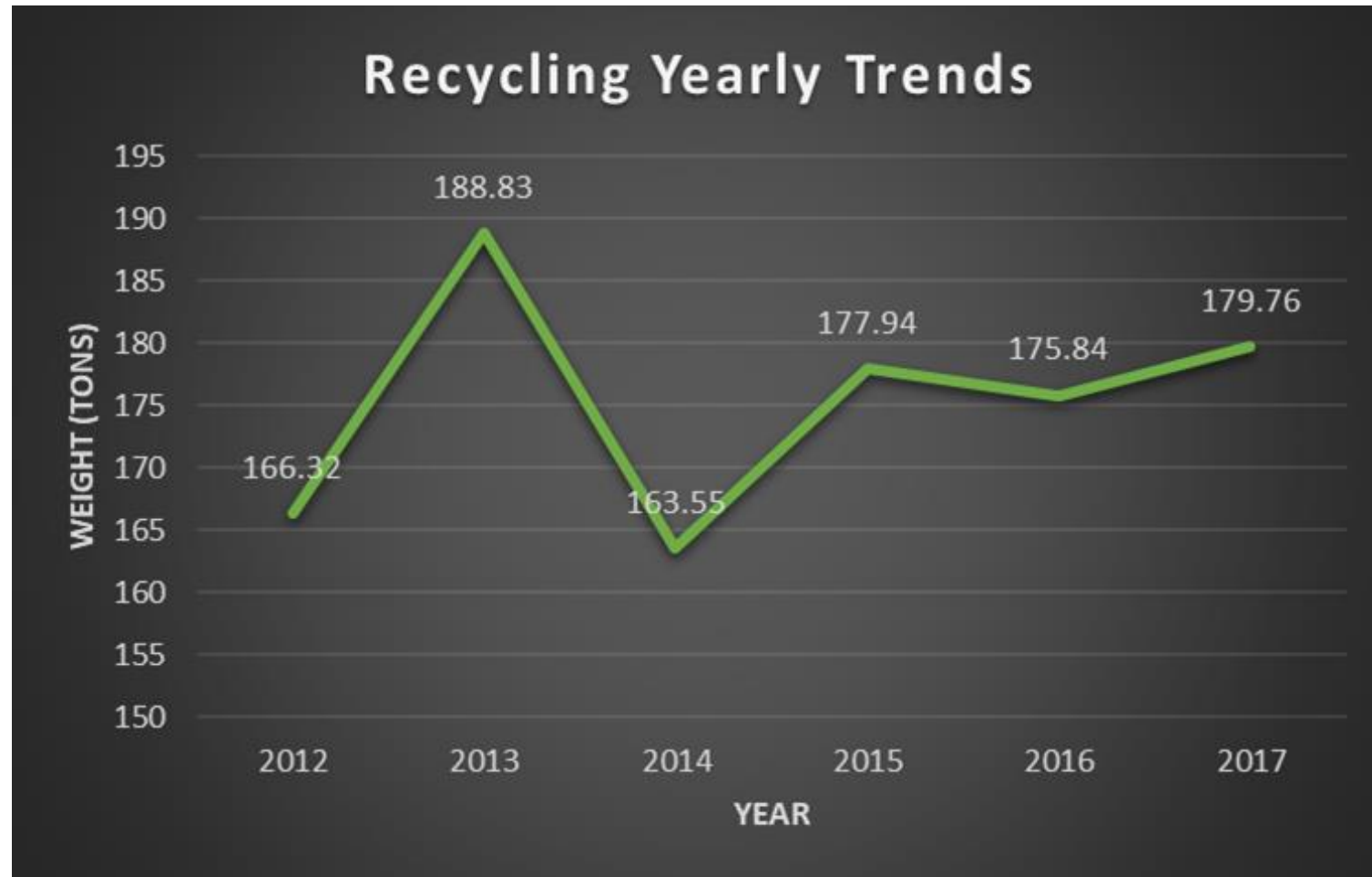
Looking at...

Tons of Trash Collected at Fairfield University from 2012-2017

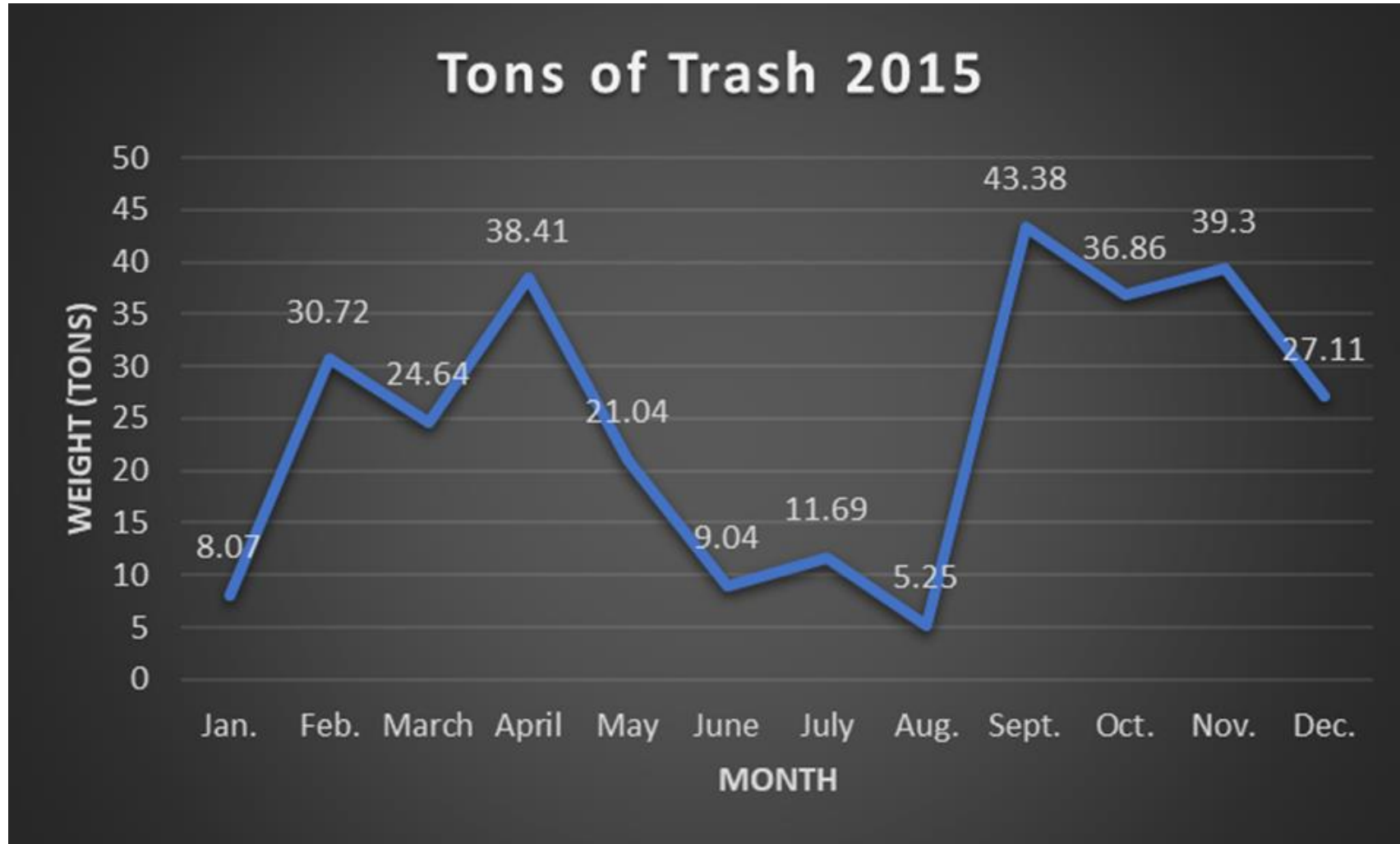


Tons of Recycling Collected from 2012-2017

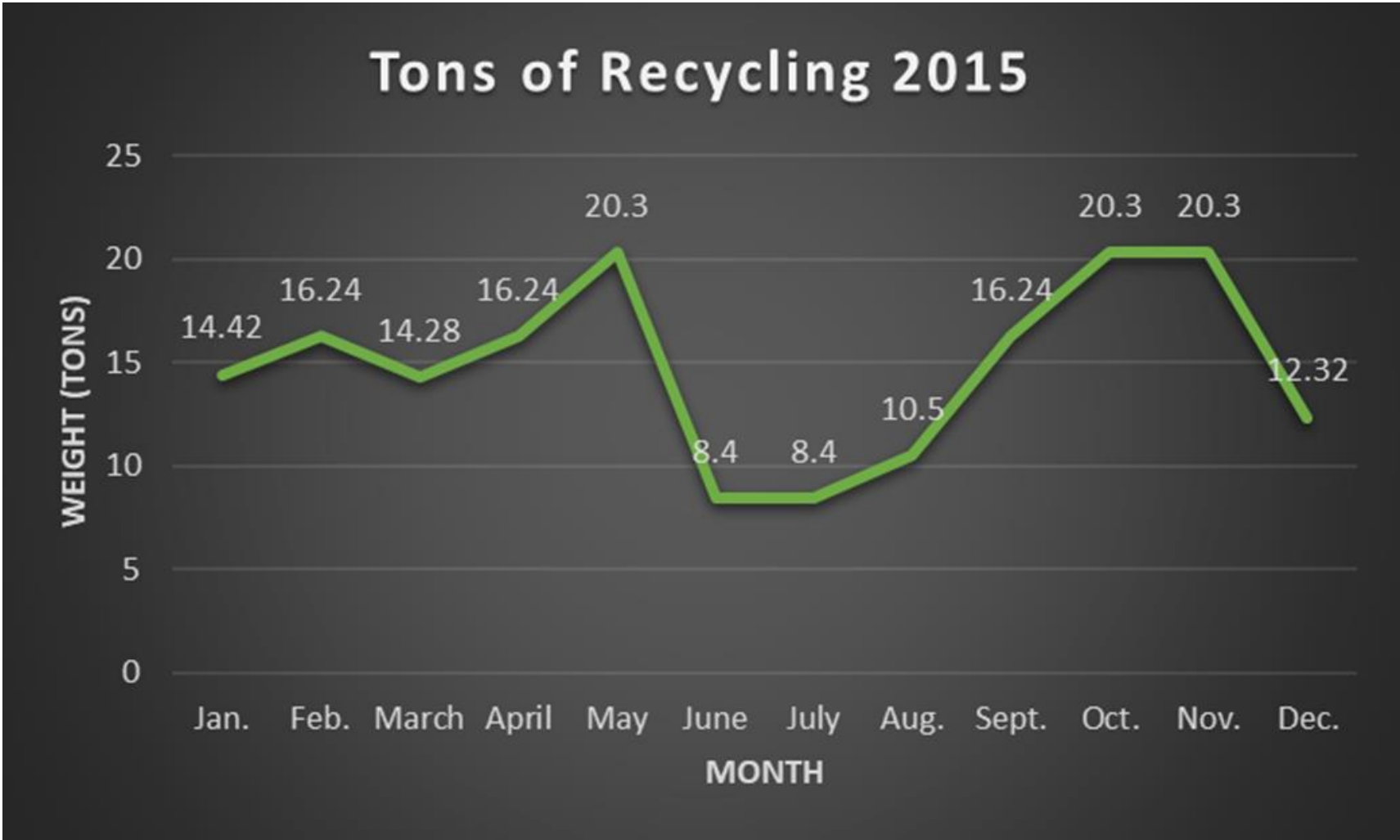

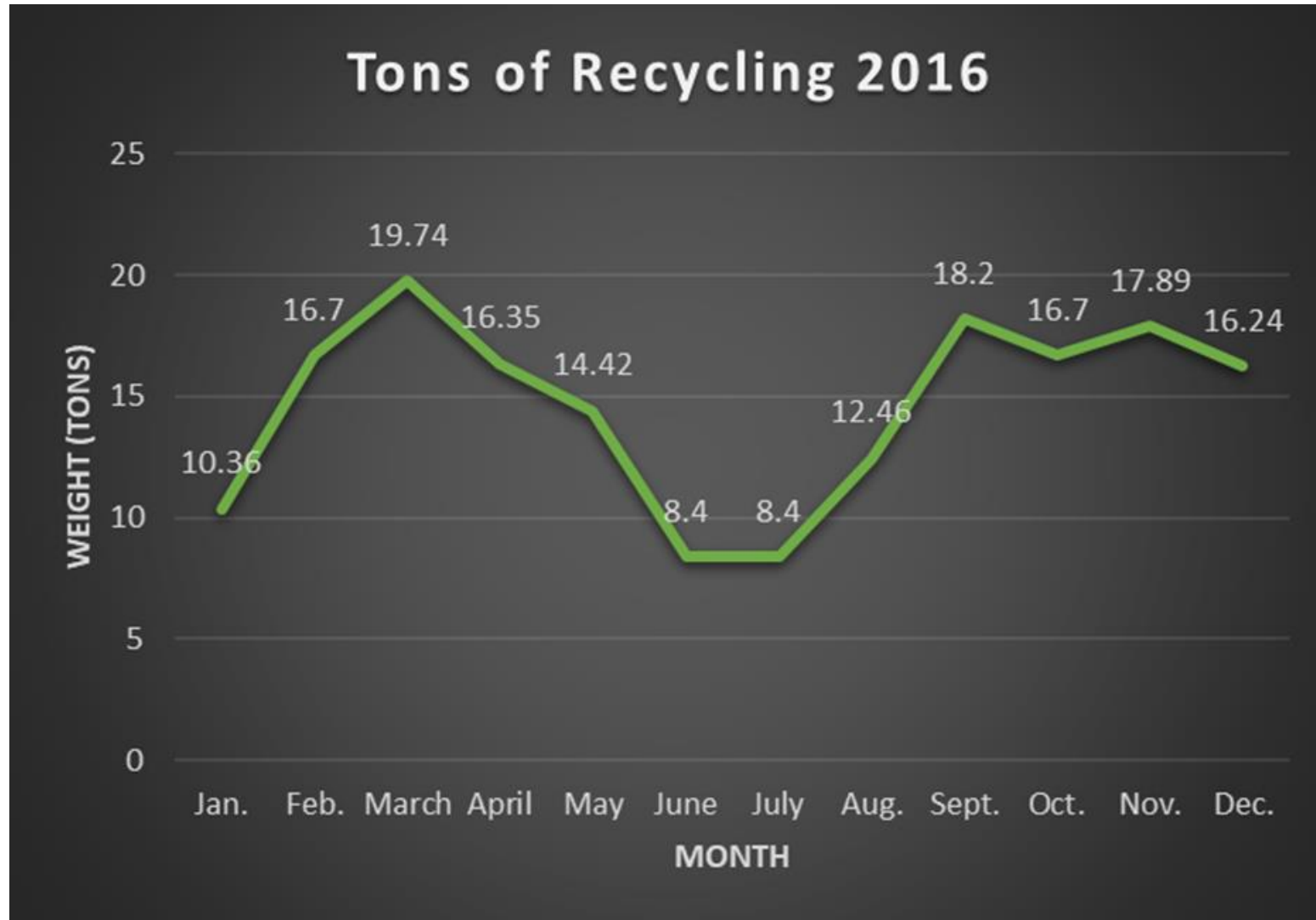

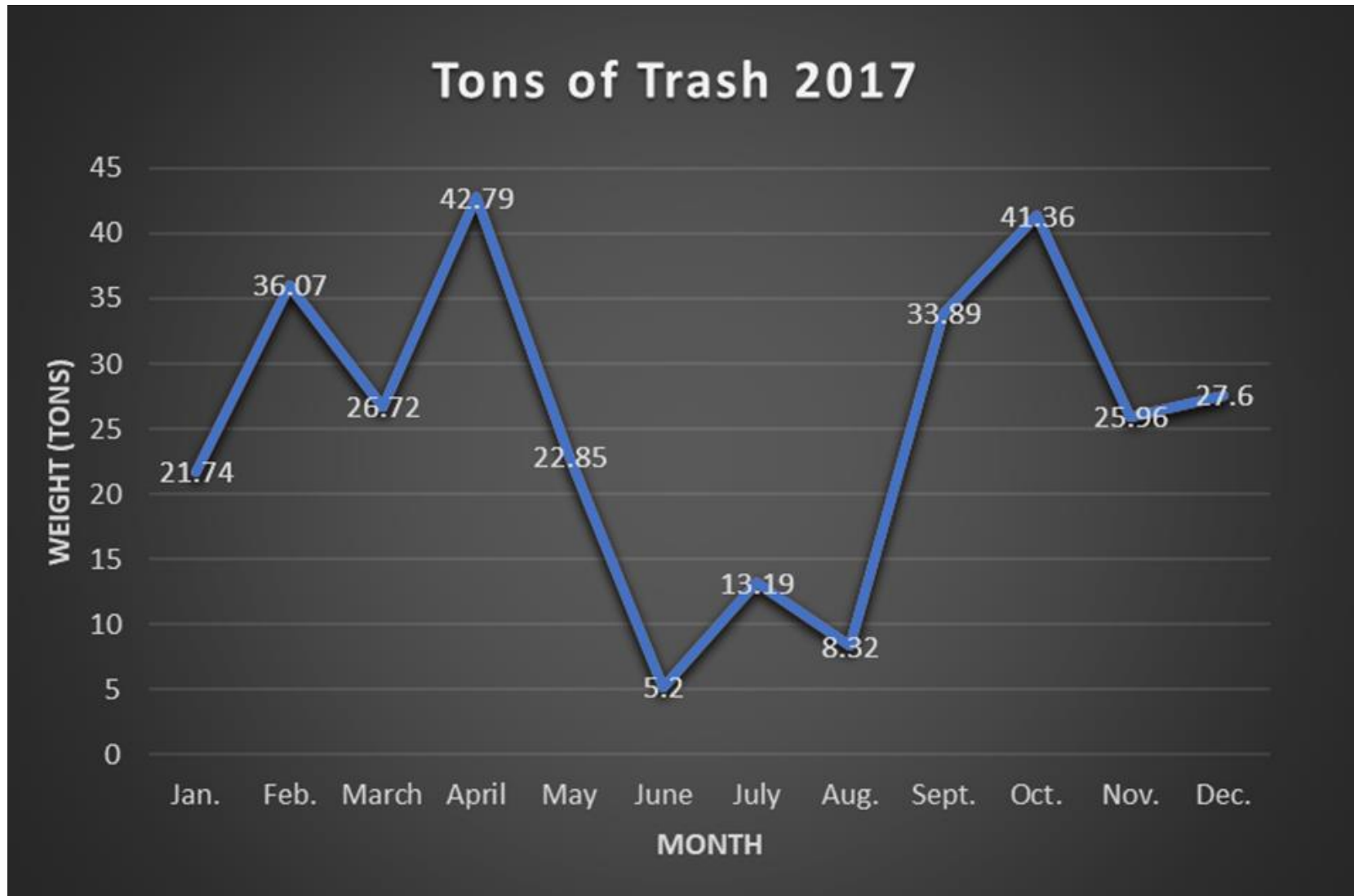

NLR Data from 2015



- ▶ 1221 pounds of batteries
 - ▶ Alkaline, lithium, lead
- ▶ 3431 pounds of lamps
 - ▶ Floor, compact, fluorescent, incandescent
- ▶ 1516 pounds of keyboards
- ▶ 2611 pounds of televisions
- ▶ Overall, 8779 pounds of electronics were collected and recycled
